Rock Haven Medical Mall Completed

Construction is finished on the first phase of the new Rock Haven Medical Mall, 2820 E. Rock Haven Road, Harrisonville, Mo. The building's first tenant, Harrisonville Family Medicine, will open its new offices Monday, Feb. 21.

The medical mall is a partnership of Damon Travis, D.O., family practice physician; Aaron Travis, D.O., internist; Shaun Holden, M.D., family practice physician; Danny Carroll, M.D., orthopedic surgeon; LeAnne Dickerson, pharmacist; and Mike Atcheson, real estate developer. The building was designed by Davidson Architecture and Engineering, Lenexa, Kan. The general contractor for the project is Capital Construction Co., Lee's Summit, Mo.

In addition to Harrisonville Family Medicine, Rock Haven Medical Mall's major tenants include Gillen Pharmacy, Bone and Joint Specialists, P.C., Cass Regional Medical Center physicians, Research Medical Center physicians and St. Joseph Medical Center/K.C. Cardiology.

"We're thrilled to be moving into our new space and believe our patients will find it much more inviting and customer-friendly," says Damon Travis, D.O. Dr. Travis' partners include Aaron Travis, D.O., and Shaun Holden, M.D. Other providers in the practice include James Lawrenzi, D.O., Kandice Fleming, M.D., Marsha Burris, F.N.P., and Deana Moore, F.N.P.

"We think our patients will like the convenience of having a retail pharmacy in the building, along with access to other medical specialists and the hospital campus services," Dr. Travis says.

Phase I of the Rock Haven Medical Mall is a 44,000-square foot, two-story medical office building located adjacent to Cass Regional Medical Center. The building's interior and exterior complement the hospital architecturally, incorporating elements of nature in the design, and framing up a focal point of the hospital campus, the Healing Garden.

To accommodate future growth, the Rock Haven Medical Mall includes a second phase of construction consisting of a 33,000 square foot building which would attach to the facility's atrium. This building also would be dedicated to physician office space and medical services. The owners anticipate construction on Phase II could begin as early as 2013.

Established in 1989 by Dr. Damon Travis, Harrisonville Family Medicine serves patients from a seven-county area including Bates, Cass, Jackson and Johnson counties in Missouri; and Johnson, Miami and Linn counties in Kansas. The practice currently consists of five physicians and two nurse practitioners who provide a wide range of services to meet the entire family's health care needs, from infants to older adults.
